The City Council of the City of Center Point, Alabama met in Regular Session at the Center Point City Hall on Thursday, March 4, at 6:30 p.m.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Council President D.M. Collins.

Invocation: President D.M. Collins led a prayer.

Council President D.M. Collins presented the agenda for consideration. Councilwoman Tiffany Moore made a motion to adopt the agenda. Councilwoman Sharon Jones seconded the motion. Upon voice vote, the agenda was unanimously adopted.

Councilwoman Tiffany Moore made a motion for unanimous consent to adopt the Consent Agenda. Councilwoman Sharon Jones seconded the motion. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action

1. Mr. Brock petitioned the council to allow his company 2410 Entertainment, LLC to use Hillcrest Manor and the Senior Center to film a sitcom pilot. The movie will be faith based. The plan is to start filming April 24th & 25th. He previously worked with Tyler Perry and has over 10 years of experience. Forty kids will be able to visit the set to meet the actors and see the behind scenes activities. If the council approves there will be an application process.

Councilwoman Tiffany Moore made a motion to accept the street light proposal. Councilwoman Sharon Jones seconded the motion. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Scott- welcomed Mr. Brock to the city and excited about the filming of the movie. The next City Clean Up and Flower giveaway is scheduled April 24, 2021. Soccer registration for kids 4-12 is open.

Councilwoman Moore- in the process of looking for people to sign up for Neighborhood Watch Program. The April meeting will be with business owners to get their input with public safety concerns.
