Mayor Scott presented the reports for departments that were not present. Community Center construction has begun, and Baseball Season begins March 14th.

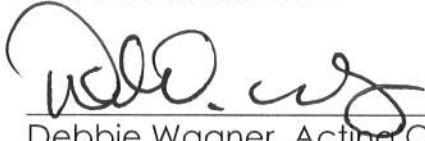
Public Safety 15k tickets have been issued and \$18k was collected

The Annual Mayor's Prayer breakfast location and time change is 9am at Center Point High School, tomorrow.

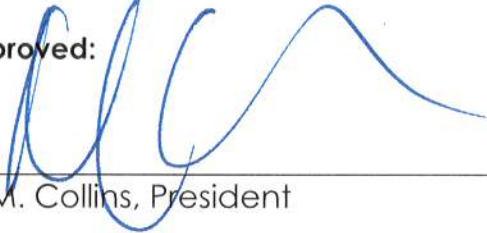
