E. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

President Williams presented the agenda for consideration. Councilman Whitaker made a motion to adopt the agenda; Council President Pro Tem Deloach seconded the motion. Upon voice vote, the agenda was adopted unanimously.

1. Pro Tem Deloach made a motion to discuss Resolution No. 2025-88 Rescind Resolution No. 2025-87
Councilor Whitaker seconded the motion. Upon voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.
