A. Call to Order

Councilman Stokes made a motion to appoint Mayor Scott as the voting delegate and Councilman Whitaker as the alternate voting delegate for the ALM Business Meeting. Councilman Whitaker seconded the motion. Upon voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.



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
